As the first center in Europe to adopt Unilateral Biportal Endoscopy (UBE), with over 1,200 successful cases, and with deep expertise in uniportal techniques, our team is uniquely positioned to guide you through the synergies, differences, and complementary roles of these two approaches.

Why this edition is different:

The endoscopic spine landscape has evolved. Uniportal and biportal techniques are often presented as competing philosophies, but we believe the future belongs to surgeons who master both. Each technique offers distinct advantages:

- Uniportal: Single incision, faster recovery, less tissue trauma, ideal for selected cases
- Biportal: Superior visualization, bimanual dexterity, optimal for complex stenosis

Recent systematic reviews and meta-analyses demonstrate that uniportal and biportal endoscopy deliver comparable clinical outcomes in terms of MacNab scores, functional improvement, and patient satisfaction. The question is no longer "which is better," but "which approach is most appropriate for this pathology, in this patient, in this surgeon's hands?"

The Neurocore-SENSED consensus — an international Delphi process involving 77 spine surgeons from Europe, Asia, and North America — has established the first standardized framework for patient selection, technical parameters, and outcome reporting in endoscopic spine surgery. This course is designed to align with these emerging evidence-based standards.

This course will not simply teach both techniques in isolation. We will explore their integration, clinical decision-making, and when to choose one over the other—or how to combine them for optimal patient outcomes. Whether you are new to endoscopy or an experienced surgeon, this course will expand your surgical armamentarium and elevate your practice to the next level.
